Treasurer's Report: Sharon Phillips presented the Treasurers Report. Opening Balance is \$861.50. Expenses for the period were \$82.00. Revenue for the period was \$111.40. Closing balance is \$890.90(copy attached). Total balance including the \$800.00 deposit with the Board is \$1690.90. The Sunshine Club previously allotted up to a maximum of \$600.00 towards the bake oven for the fire pit area. This has not yet come out of the account.

Past Events:

- **Ladies Luncheon** – Evelyn Phillips commented on the Ladies luncheon held at the Ranch Café in Keremeos. Eight ladies attended and a great time was had by all.
- **The Boys Breakfast** - Lis Rettke commented on the breakfast for **Joe Kivimaki**. Thank you **Joe and boys** for a great job. Twenty seven people attended. This is the last breakfast hosted by Joe Kivimaki for the season. **Dale Chadsey** agreed to host the venue until he leaves on his bike trip in June. He will line up volunteers. The ladies will host the **“Father’s Day”** breakfast.

Events Still To Be Held In April:

- **Easter Dinner** – April 21st, 2019. **Maureen Walker** agreed to host this event. Volunteers have been contacted to assist.
- **Spring Auction and Potluck** – April 22nd, 2019. **Lis Rettke** reminded Members that this is a 25 cent auction so bring quarters and money for the 50/50.

Old Business:

- **Wax Food Saver Art Class** – This class was put on by **Maureen Walker** and **Lis Rettke**. Members who attended enjoyed the class.
- **Bake Oven Progress** – **Dale Chadsey** brought Members up to date on prices he had obtained for supplies to proceed with the bake oven. He informed them that costs were high and he needed volunteer help with the project to obtain some of the supplies. **Vicki Matchett** agreed to assist him in putting a list together and notifying members so they may assist in obtaining materials. An announcement is to be made at the Easter Dinner if the project is to proceed. **Sharon Phillips** suggested that the Sunshine Club could donate more money if necessary.
