Old Business

Discussion on Covid 19 restrictions as they may affect our activities, especially group functions indoors.

We won't plan events in the clubhouse as of yet. Esther is considering doing coffee in Central Park, provided weather and mosquitos don't make it impossible.

Date for Spring Clean of clubhouse set for June 24, 10 AM until NOON.

Decision made to dispose of our old dinner plates in favour of buying some Corelle replacements. The old ones might get used as material for mosaic style tiling on pizza oven.

It has been suggested that some park benches would be a welcome addition to our park. A few possible locations include near the office, near the walkway next to # 164 (Don and Linda's), on the grassy spot beside #108 (Boehm's), and down near the river, off to the side of the firepit area. All members present agreed by a show of hands that this is a good idea.

Evelyn J. and Peggy will look around in Penticton to check durability and price range on benches. Dale Chadsey has already found a good design and has offered to build benches, if asked to. We will look at the stores first to help decide on what would make the best investment.

Election Terry B. volunteers to be Treasurer. She plans to be at SK right through the winter this year. Barb G. volunteers to be Chairperson for 6 months, and to provide for a secretary as well. Vicki will help her whenever needed.

Walkway signs need replacing. This will be brought to the board's attention.

Paths through grassy areas came up but this is a board responsibility, and gravel in these areas is not desirable as it interferes with mowing.
